**Questions and Answers have been paraphrased and summarized*

3PM MEETING

1. Q: [Ms. B]: Will we be relocated at this time?

A: [Jonathan Rogers, DCHA]: We know that there will need to be temporary resident relocation for DCHA to renovate the apartments; however these relocations will not exceed 60 days. Given the scope of the improvements, these renovations will likely take several weeks. We will be developing a more definitive timeline over the coming months as we work with the General Contractor. We will strive to shrink this temporary relocation time as much as possible and we will share more information in November.

2. Q: [Ms. B]: Where will be relocated to during the renovations?

A: [Jonathan Rogers, DCHA]: We don't have an exact answer for this right now, but our goal is to try to keep everyone in the area during the temporary relocation. We do know that we will not be able to keep everyone on site during the renovation. Instead, families will likely be temporarily relocated to other DCHA public housing properties or hotels. We will work with you and your family to make sure you will be adequately accommodated.
